

- Lake area of HAB swimming advisory

Sampling at 4 sites in the Upper & Middle North Anna & Pamunkey Branches occurred on 6/17/2024. Results for one site in the Upper North Anna Branch, which represents the waterbody from the headwaters of North Anna River to the Rte. 522 bridge, contained cyanobacteria at levels which pose a health concern. One cyanotoxin was detected at both Upper North Anna and Pamunkey Branch sites but were below levels of health concern. Two samples collected 6/4/24 at Lake Anna State Park and the "Splits" contained results that were acceptable.
