
Lake Anna HAB Status Report – Advisory Update for North Anna Branch; Pamunkey Branch; Terry's Run Branch

Issued: Friday 9/27/2024 Next Issue: on or about the week of 10/21/24



Monitoring at 7 sites in Lake Anna above Rt. 208 occurred on 9/18/24. 2 sites on the Pamunkey Branch and 1 on Terry's Run indicated a cyanobacteria bloom with cell concentrations at unsafe levels. The 2 sites in the North Anna Branch, 1 site in the Pamunkey and Lake Anna State Park site contained acceptable cell concentrations. All cyanotoxin results were below detectable levels. Swimming advisories remain in place until two samples at least 10 days apart, indicate both cyanobacteria counts and cyanotoxin are below guidance levels. **No changes to the current advisories are recommended.** The HAB map and this status report have been updated and are posted at www.SwimHealthyVA.com.
