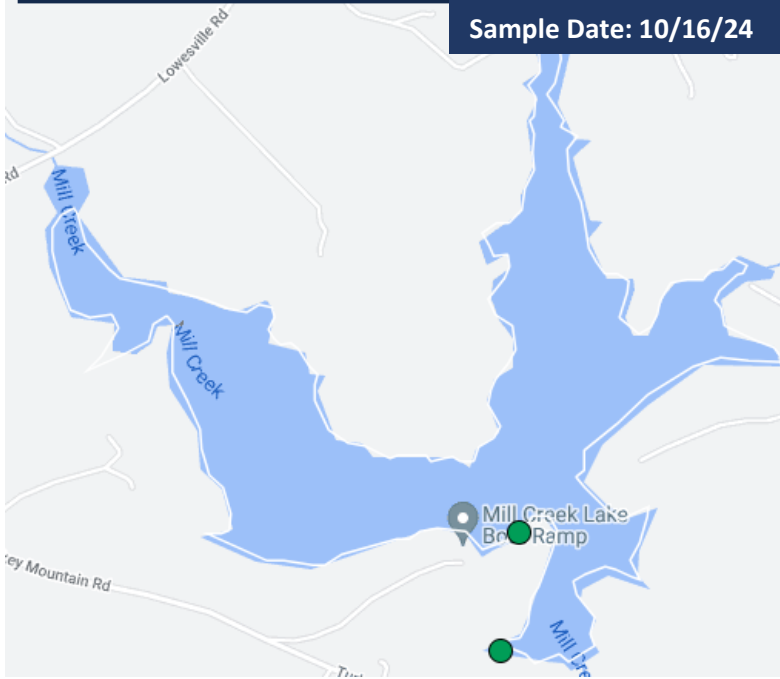


Mill Creek Lake-HAB Status Report

Swimming Advisory Lifted-Advisory no longer in effect

Expand the map using the symbol in the upper right hand map title bar, then click on the magnifying glass. You can search by location name or address.

-  Harmful algal (cyanobacteria) concentrations at unsafe levels
-  Algal concentrations at acceptable levels
-  Lake area of HAB swimming advisory

Samples with cyanobacteria and toxin concentrations at safe levels were collected on October 16, allowing VDH to lift the swimming advisory on Mill Creek Lake. **There is currently no HAB advisory on Mill Creek Lake.** Investigations at two locations; the swimming beach and the dam, collected 10/16/24 showed acceptable levels of algae. Toxins were also at acceptable levels, and generally below detectable concentrations. The HAB map and this status report have been updated and are posted at <http://www.SwimHealthyVA.com>.
