In this job aid, users will learn how to use the new merge feature to handle duplicate client records when initiating a data transfer from VASE+ to WebVISION. This feature can be used when clients with the same first name, last name, and date of birth have multiple appointments in the same event. This functionality is available to users with the VASE+ Web VISION District Admin or Site Admin roles.

Initiate Data Transfer in VASE+

First, navigate to the "Transfer Data to WebVISION" tab. Next, select the "Start" option for that data you wish to transfer. If you would like to view additional details, including the client count, select "See Details" (Figure 1).

Upon selecting "Start", a pop-up will appear with additional event details. To confirm the data transfer, select "Submit" (Figure 2).

If there are duplicate client records, the Status will update to "Failed". To view error messages with details regarding the data transfer fail, select "See details" next to the event (Figure 3).

Edit Duplicate Record

Registrants that have duplicate appointments will appear on the report with the following error message "*Same Client under multiple appointments. Please Merge Vaccination Records*". In order to rectify this issue, select the edit icon next to one of the line items associated with a client (Figure 4).

Upon selecting edit, users will be brought to the Review page for the selected appointment. Under the Vaccination Details section, there is an option to merge the records (Figure 5). Users will receive a pop-up message where they can review the details and confirm the merge. Upon selecting the "Merge" button, the duplicate appointments will be associated with each-other.
