CARES Act Provider Relief Fund, Phase 2 General Distribution

Application Deadline: Friday, August 28, 2020

Many healthcare providers are experiencing financial hardships in the COVID-19 pandemic. Congress provided \$175 billion in relief funds to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) to deliver financial relief to hospitals and other health care providers, including those on the front lines of the coronavirus response. Those who bill Medicare, Medicaid, Medicaid Managed Care, CHIP, or a dental provider are eligible to apply as long as they haven't already received 2% of their patient revenue from the fund.
