New CDC Social Media Campaign, "#Sleeve Up to #Fight Flu"



The new Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) social media campaign, "#SleeveUp to #FightFlu" aims to encourage everyone aged 6 months and older to get the flu vaccine. Widespread vaccination will help reduce the strain on health care systems responding to the COVID-19 pandemic. The CDC's preliminary estimates for the 2019-2020 flu season include up to 740,000 hospitalizations and up to 62,000 deaths.

HRSA Rural Health Care Services Outreach Program

Application Deadline: December 1, 2020

The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) will make 60 awards with total funding of \$12.75 million to enhance the delivery of health care services in rural communities. Eligible applicants are public and private, nonprofit and for-profit entities with demonstrated ability to serve rural populations. Applicants must represent a network of three or more health care provider organizations; at least two-thirds of these must be located in a [HRSA-designated rural area](#).
