

For Week Ending March 1, 2025:




- Overall respiratory illness activity* in Virginia is LOW and TRENDING DOWN
- Among all emergency department visits in Virginia:
 - Dx COVID 1.0% of ED visits
 - Dx Influenza 4.8% of ED visits
 - Dx RSV .1% of ED visits







COVID-19, Flu, & RSV in Virginia

For Week Ending March 1, 2025:








The largest proportion of ED visits by age group were among 0-4 years old for COVID-19, 0-4 years for influenza, and 0-4 years for RSV


